

PRIVACY NOTICE

Articles 13 and 14 of EU Regulation 2016/679

CUSTOMERS/SUPPLIERS

This privacy notice is drafted pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 ("GDPR"), Legislative Decree 196/2003 as amended by Legislative Decree 101/2018 ("Privacy Code"), as well as in compliance with the Provision of the Italian Data Protection Authority of 8 April 2010 on video surveillance and EDPB Guidelines 3/2019.

Data Controller

The Data Controller is FLASH BATTERY S.R.L., with registered office at Via XXV Aprile Ovest, 23/A – 42049 Sant'Ilario d'Enza (RE) – Italy. For the exercise of the rights granted to data subjects, it is possible to write to: privacy@flashbattery.tech

Purposes and legal basis of processing

Personal data are processed for the following purposes:

- Establishment and performance of the supply or service contract, including pre-contractual and management phases;
- Compliance with legal, tax, accounting and administrative obligations, including those relating to public health.

The personal data of natural persons acting in the name and on behalf of customer legal entities provided are processed by the Data Controller in order to:

- o send communications of various kinds and through different means of communication: telephone, mobile phone, SMS, email, fax, paper mail;
- o formulate requests or handle requests received;
- o exchange information aimed at performing the contractual relationship, including pre-contractual and post-contractual activities;
- o carry out the operations necessary for the processing of orders and other requests.

The legal bases for the processing are Article 6, paragraph 1, letters b) and c) GDPR, as well as the legitimate interest of the Controller pursuant to Article 6, letter f) GDPR.

Types of data processed

The data processed may include: name, surname, tax data, contact details, bank details. Such data are collected and processed for contractual and legal purposes.

Video surveillance

A video surveillance system is active at the company premises, duly indicated by appropriate signage, for the purposes of protecting company assets and ensuring security. The images are stored for a maximum period of 7 days.

Methods of data processing

Personal data will be processed by the Company and by the persons authorized to do so within the master data records, stored in our databases and processed by both electronic/telematic and paper-based means, in accordance with legal principles and protecting the confidentiality of the data subject and his/her rights through the adoption of appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure a level of security appropriate to the risk.

The provision of data is mandatory for the performance of the contract and compliance with regulatory obligations. Any refusal will make it impossible to establish or continue the contractual relationship.

Communication, dissemination and transfer of data

The data may be communicated to:

- banks, legal, tax and IT consultants;
- internal authorized persons or External Processors;
- competent authorities in the cases provided for by law.

No transfer of data outside the EU is envisaged. In the event of use of cloud services, the measures referred to in Articles 45 et seq. GDPR will be adopted.

Data retention period

The data will be retained for the entire duration of the contractual relationship and subsequently for the periods provided for by law or necessary to protect the rights of the Controller. Video surveillance images will be deleted 7 days after recording.

Rights of the data subject

As Data Subject, you may exercise the rights provided for by Articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 20, 21 and 22 of the GDPR by sending your requests to the following contact:

In particular, pursuant to Article 13, paragraph 2, letter b) GDPR, in relation to the processing of the personal data in question, in order to ensure fair and transparent processing, the following rights may be exercised:

- Right to information and access under Article 15 GDPR: in order to obtain from the Data Controller information on whether or not data processing concerning you exists, as well as access to your personal data and information on the purposes of the processing, the recipients or categories of recipients to whom the data are transmitted.
- Right to rectification under Article 16 GDPR, erasure under Article 17 GDPR and restriction under Article 18 GDPR: in order to request from the Data Controller the rectification and erasure of your personal data and the restriction of processing.
- Right to data portability under Article 20 GDPR: in order to receive, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, the personal data concerning you provided to the Data Controller, and you have the right to transmit those data to another controller, provided that such operation is technically feasible.
- Right to object under Article 21 GDPR: in order to object to the processing of your data.

Furthermore, we inform you that you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Italian Supervisory Authority, the "Garante per la Protezione dei Dati Personali", if you believe that your rights have been violated by the Controller and/or by a third party.
