

Flash Battery 3-time winner as Best Under-40 in Emilia-Romagna

For the third time, Reggio Emilia's Flash Battery wins the title as "best under-40 enterprise" in the Emilia Romagna region during the "Industria Felix"- l'Italia che compete" event.

Italy's best-selling lithium battery manufacturer for industrial machinery and electric vehicles, based in Sant'llario d'Enza, impressed the award's jury panel after reviewing the financial statements of 700,000 LLC companies during the selection process.

Flash Battery was selected as the best under 40 company of Emilia Romagna, after ending the 2022 fiscal year with revenues of €22.3 million (+29% over 2021), direct exports of €4.6 million, and a 22.2% increase in new hires, with the number of employees now at 80 units averaging 34 years of age.

Among the youngest of the crew are co-founders Marco Righi and Alan Pastorelli themselves – 38 and 39 years of age, respectively.

The award was organised by the Michele Montemurro-managed Industria Felix Magazine (Italy's most authoritative financial newspaper) in collaboration with the Cerved Centre for Studies and the Luiss Guido Carli University.
